



Aquatic Technicians and Crew Leaders Needed

Aquatic Technicians and Crew Leaders are responsible for aquatic vegetation and algae control in ponds and water features at public and private locations throughout Northern California. Those holding a qualified applicator license or certification QAL/QAC with a category F (aquatics) are strongly encouraged to apply.



Basic Job Requirements:

- Must be comfortable working on boats and a proficient swimmer.
- Must be able eligible to drive company vehicles.
- Working in waders or wet suits to manually remove vegetation and/or debris from waterbodies.
- Use of mechanical equipment to remove aquatic and riparian vegetation from waterbodies and embankments.
- Ability to apply pesticides (herbicides and algaecides).
- Ability to lift at least 50 lbs.

Desirable skills

- Experience with pesticides handling and safety.
- Operation of small boats.
- Ability to install/repair plumbing, pumps and/or compressors for aeration/circulation systems.
- Basic construction skills.
- Spanish speaking a plus.
