**WHO:** Dola Flake is a doctoral student at the University of Arkansas, studying Public Policy in Social Justice. Dola is an experienced diversity trainer and master level social worker and has been working to create inclusive spaces through Equity Diversity Inclusion (EDI) education since 2017. In 2019, she completed her certification as an EDI trainer from NCCJ St. Louis, a premier diversity training institute. Dola has provided EDI training to over 2000 individuals and in 2021 she was honored with the Joplin Magazine Pathfinder Award for her efforts to promote Equity Diversity Inclusion.

In addition to providing access to EDI training throughout the Midwest region, Dola serves in various roles as a community volunteer. She is currently vice-chairperson for the Emancipation Committee of Joplin and a board member of JoMOEQ, both organizations strive to create inclusive spaces for underrepresented populations. Dola is also cofounder of Joplin for Justice, a community group working to promote equity and inclusion for all people.
